Issue/Topic:

Brandied History LLC has completed the Johns Homestead Preservation Study, and results were used to submit an application to the State Historic Preservation Office for inclusion on the National Registry for Historic Places. Once designated as an historic place, a site becomes eligible for grant funding or tax incentives which can be used to support design, planning, and construction activities.
